

André NEL, Romain GARROUSTE, Günther BECHLY, Burkhard POHL & François ESCUILLIÉ. –  
***Rafaeliana*, a replacement generic name for *Rafaelia* Nel et al., 2005 (Neuropterida)**

Dr Christian Kammerer (University of Chicago) has been called to our attention that the generic name *Rafaelia*, established by NEL et al. (2005) for *Rafaelia maxima* Nel et al., 2005, and *Rafaelia minima* Nel et al., 2005, is a junior homonym of *Rafaelia* Townsend, 1917 (Diptera, Sarcophagidae). In accordance with Article 60 of the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature (International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature, 1999), we propose *Rafaeliana* as a replacement genus name. The two species, the gender (feminine), and the etymology remain as given by NEL et al. (2005), as do the generic diagnosis and the family name Rafaelidae NEL et al., 2005, proposed for these taxa.
